
12 Weeks of Christmas



Week 5: Sweetest Christmas Triangle Box

Step #1:

- Score 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" piece of Evening Evergreen at 4-1/4" on the 8-1/2" side.
- Using a ruler and stylus, make a score line from the 4-1/2" score line on the top of the 8-1/2" side of cardstock to the right center of the 5-1/2" side (2-3/4") as shown in photo. Using a ruler and stylus, make a score line from the 4-1/2" score line at the bottom of the 8-1/2" side of cardstock to the right center of the 5-1/2" (2-3/4") side as shown on photo.
- Repeat score lines on the left-hand side of cardstock as shown in photo.



Step #2

- Fold score lines and burnish with bone folder.
 Fold box in half overlapping sides to assemble.
- Use 1/4" handheld circle punch to punch circles through both layers of cardstock on each side of box.
- Tie Real Red Ribbon through holes in box and tie in bow to close.



Step #3

- Trim 4-3/4" x 3-3/4" piece of Painted Christmas
 Designer Series Paper from center of 4-3/4" side
 (2-3/8") to bottom right-hand and bottom left-hand sides of paper creating a triangle. (tip: Pay
 attention to pattern it should run horizontal on
 the 4-3/4" side of paper.)
- Adhere triangle to front of box using adhesive.



Step #4

- Cut circle from 2" x 2" piece of Evening Evergreen cardstock using die from Stylish Shapes Dies using die-cutting machine.
- Stamp sentiment from Sweet Candy Canes stamp set onto 1-1/2" x 1-1/2" piece of Basic White cardstock using Evening Evergreen ink. Cut out with circle die from Stylish Shapes Dies using die-cutting machine. Adhere it to Evening Evergreen circle using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Cut two evergreen boughs from 3" x 3" piece of Evening Evergreen cardstock with die from Christmas banners dies using die-cutting machine.
- Cut one branch from scrap of Soft Suede cardstock with die from Christmas Banners dies using die-cutting machine.
- Stamp two holly leaf images from Christmas Banners stamp set onto scrap of Soft Succulent cardstock with Garden Green ink. Cut out with die from Christmas Banners dies using die-cutting machine.
- Stamp holly berry images from Christmas Banners stamp set onto scrap of Basic White cardstock using Real Red ink. Cut out with die from Christmas Banners dies using die-cutting machine.



Step #5

- Adhere sentiment tag to bottom right-hand side of box using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Tuck two evergreen bough die-cuts behind sentiment tag using MultiPurpose Liquid Glue to adhere to box.
- Adhere holly berry die-cuts to branch die-cut using MultiPurpose Liquid Glue. Tuck two branch die-cut behind sentiment tag using MultiPurpose Liquid Glue to adhere to box.
- Tuck two holly leaf die-cuts behind sentiment tag using MultiPurpose Liquid Glue to adhere to box.
- Adhere Adhesive Backed Seasonal Sequins to base of holly leaves on box front.
